

EXHIBIT RULES

PRIZES

Awards for technologist and student exhibits will be considered separately.

FIRST PLACE	\$200.00 cash and certificate
SECOND PLACE	\$100.00 cash and certificate
THIRD PLACE	\$ 50.00 cash and certificate

Certificates awarded to all participants

ELIGIBILITY

- All members in good standing of the LSRT are eligible to compete for awards. Membership must be current for year Exhibit is judged. (exceptions listed below)
- The following members **may not** participate: all Elected Officers of the Society, Annual Meeting Chairperson, Annual Meeting Co-Chairperson, Exhibit Judges, members of other state societies, or persons employed by commercial firms engaged in the sale or manufacture of radiology or imaging products.
- The exhibitor must not include test or images that could identify a patient, institution, or department
- Displays must not include applicant identification, educational program, or corporation until after judging. The display will be assigned a number prior to judging.
- Exhibits will not be considered for award if they have been displayed at any radiological meetings, (ACR, ASRT, RSNA, AMA, ETC.) However they may be displayed on a non-competitive basis.

JUDGING

The three judges shall be selected by the First Vice-President. The judges' selections will be based upon the ratings listed in the Exhibit Judging Evaluation Scale.

CRITERIA FOR AWARDS

- An exhibit must obtain a minimum average score of 65 points from the judges to be considered for any award.
- An exhibit must obtain a minimum average score of 75 points from the judges to be considered for the First Place Award.

APPLICATION FOR SPACE

- All applications for space must be forwarded to the First Vice President with a **USPS Postmark** of no later than **June 15** of the current year.
- The total space allotted for any one exhibit shall not exceed FOUR (4) 14 x 17 inch viewing space (provided by the exhibitor); or posters no larger than 4 panels (48" wide). Likewise, models, descriptive materials, handouts, charts, photographs, etc. should fit within an equal amount of space as previous allotted for posters.
- The LSRT will only provide a table for the exhibits. The exhibitor is responsible for all equipment needed for his/her exhibit.
- Displays will be set up by applicants directed by the LSRT. The participant must set up display prior to exhibition opening which will be announce in the final annual meeting program. No display may be taken down until official closing time.
- The LSRT board is not responsible for loss or damage but will take all reasonable precautions to ensure the security of displays.
- If an applicant fails to remove a display, the display will be discarded.

SUBJECT MATTER

- Exhibits must be original work of the technologist/student and not commercially prepared.
- Technologists or students may work individually or in a group.
- Subject matter should contain research pertaining to Radiologic Technology
- Content should demonstrate the following:
 - Originally of subject matter that illustrates a new idea/trend or presents information in a new, innovative style,
 - Professional and practical value that provides information of interest to technologists and students,
 - Educational value that offers viewers a learning experience, and
 - Creativity that presents material in a neat, well organized manner.
